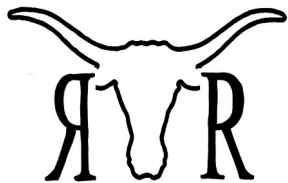

Please get started on writing your history right away. Include the following:

- Author of your history. If your family was in the previous history book, listing the page number in the previous book.
- Family name and members of the family. Marriage info, children etc. Occupation, business etc.
- Current address or land location. Residence—who owned it previously? Name of grandparents if they are from the area.. Nationality/ancestry.
- Family members that served in the Armed Forces. When and where?
- Names and locations of family members who have left the community.
- If your family lived in the area, but are no longer here, please collaborate to do a family history. A separate history for each family member may be included.
- Any special events or memories of growing up in the community.
- If possible, please submit your information in digital form (preferably Word) by e-mail attachment or on a USB flash/jump drive.
- Photos: Family photos, historical photos and photos of community events. Please provide the names of people and the date of the photo, if possible.
- Clear photos can be submitted as originals. Do not write information on back of photos. Supply name and address for return of photos. Please keep copies of original photos that you submit.
- Digital photos may be submitted as JPEG attachment. They must be scanned at 300 dpi. Please include photo information in the body of the email.

The History Book Committee reserves the right to edit submissions for purposes of length, space or duplication.

Deadline for history and photo submissions: May 31st, 2018 (New extended date)
